Shadow Day Timeline and Information

WHEN TO ARRIVE, WHAT TO WEAR, & WHAT TO BRING

Students should arrive between 8:00 and 8:10am with a 'uniform' (button up shirt and khaki pants or simple skirts, looking professional and ready to begin the day), notebook and pen for their own personal use, and a packed lunch.

WHERE TO DROP OFF

We are currently located at Our Lady of the Valley in Windsor. Parents and students should drive to the south side of the building so students can enter through the Main Church doors where they will meet a faculty representative and be shown to their proper classroom by a shadow student.

PARENT PARTICIPATION

Parents that wish to experience part of the day are welcome to join the student body at the Daily Mass (9:00am), and otherwise are only asked to join us in a conversation at the end of the day beginning at 3:20pm and lasting for thirty to sixty minutes.

EXIT MEETING

We end each day with a 'debriefing' or processing time with the students to ask them about the school day and enter into a discernment process about what will help the student better pursue sanctification. After this student-directed, student-centered conversation occurs, we have a final portion of the conversation with parents about any questions and logistics for the following year.
