



Our History, Four Years Strong: Set into Motion & Blessed by the Archbishop

In 2019, Archbishop Samuel J. Aquila wrote a letter to the Church of Northern Colorado announcing the establishment of the first and only Catholic high school in Northern CO. After years of prayer and faithful work by the people of Northern CO, St. John Paul II High School opened its doors for the first time in August 2020 with the support of the Archbishop. Although JPIIHS is not formally an archdiocesan school, it is blessed by the Archbishop and will continue to remain faithful to both the Church and the wishes of the Archbishop.

In February 2023 we welcomed the Archbishop to see visit St. John Paul II
High School. Below are his remarks in a letter he sent afterward:

"I enjoyed my visit and was deeply impressed by our conversation on participation in the Mass. As I said in Mass that morning, it has long been a dream to have a Catholic high school in Northern Colorado and I am grateful that is has finally been realized.

You, students, are coming of age in a time when faith is dismissed and derided by our culture. Although people will claim that our beliefs are "backwards" or "regressive," they cannot escape the fact that we were made for God and, as St. Augustine famously said, "our hearts are restless until they rest in Thee." The ground is fertile for evangelization and your ability to articulate the truths of the faith, alongside your joy in the Lord, will draw many to belief in God."

Northern Colorado's Only Catholic High School: Catholic Classical Education



Northern Colorado has been blessed with four parochial schools in the area (Fort Collins, Loveland, Longmont, and Greeley). However, the closest Catholic high school was in Broomfield—an hour or more away for most families. Families had been asking for a Catholic high school option for decades, the first written request being about 50 years ago. After several feasibility studies, hard work done by community members, and many prayers, St. John Paul II High School was established in August 2020!

Since then we have made much progress with having our first graduating class in 2022! We continue to work towards building our own school building while building the current school that we are blessed to have space in Our Lady of the Valley. We are excited to see what the Lord will continue to do at St. John Paul II High School.

Our curriculum is rooted in ideas and tradition greater than ourselves. Beginning with the first written documents of human history and working its way through Western Civilization's most prominent thinkers, our curriculum introduces our students to the most fundamental questions of humanity, such as: Why am I here? What is true about the world? What do I do about it? Does God exist?





Simply put, we fundraise so that we can keep tuition affordable for families so that all students might have the opportunity for an authentically Catholic education during this crucial stage of their life.

Keeping Catholic Education an Option for Families

If, as St. John Paul II said, Catholic education in the United States is an investment in our culture and in the Church, and this school truly creates disciples for Christ, then it is a worthy and far-reaching investment for us as Catholics to help make Catholic education an option for families. A study in 2021 from hundreds of families across Northern Colorado parishes reveals that at least 40% of interested families would need tuition assistance.


Currently, from the families we serve 60% of our students receive some type of financial assistance.


