



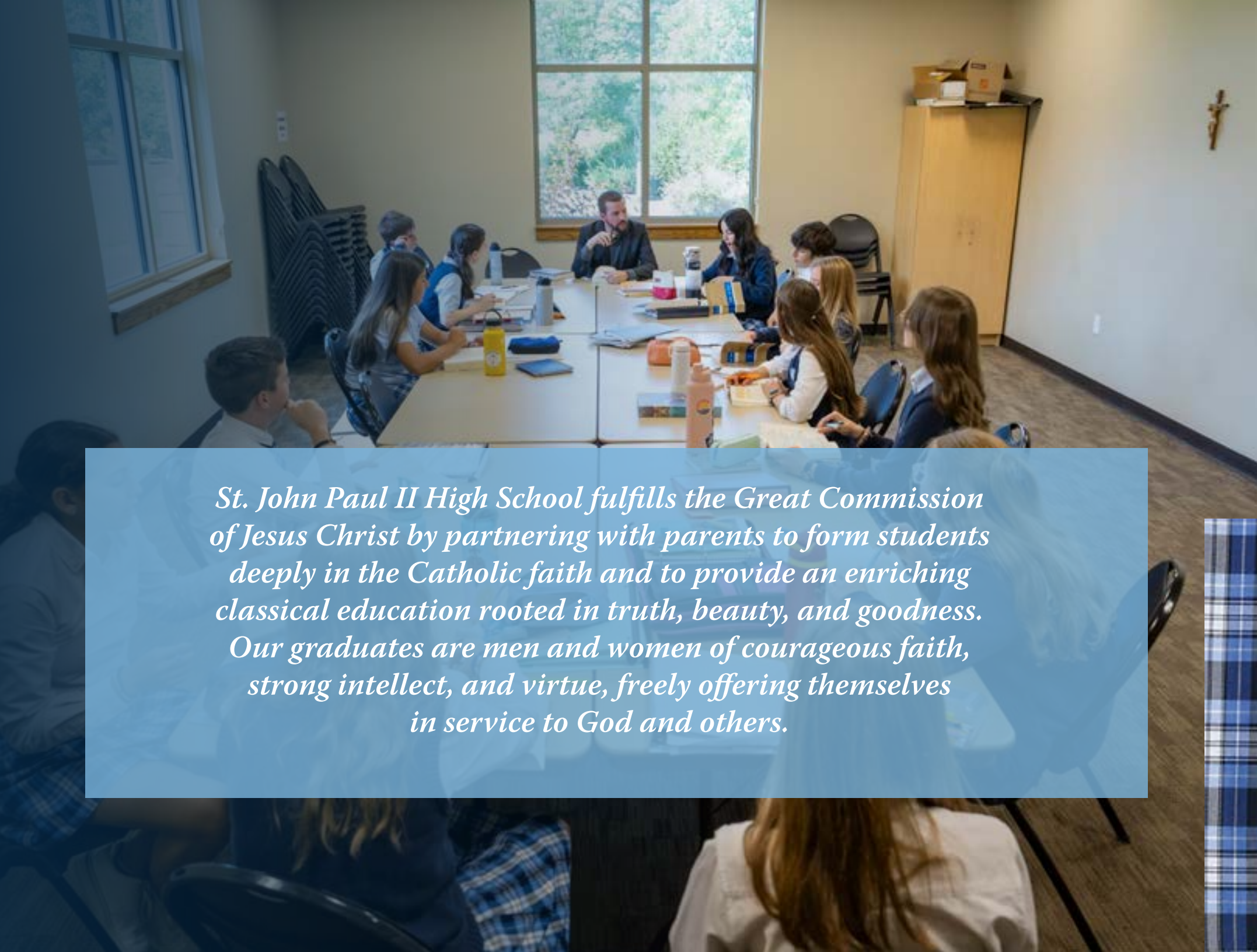

Dear Friends,

The 2024-25 school year saw much beautiful fruit - in particular, that the second of our male graduates joined the seminary. In the last 3 years, that is 15% of total male graduates to join the seminary, not to mention some of our female graduates who are in active discernment for religious life. This makes us the most prolific school for vocations in the state! Our school seeks to educate all but a second committed vocation is hard to let pass by.

While last year was winding down, we discovered a solution to our need for a new location, one big enough for us to increase our offerings but close enough for present and future students to come to. By the grace of God, 1500 Monroe Ave. in Loveland came to us. Within a year of its discovery, we purchased and started the remodel and will take occupancy in it very soon. Be sure and keep an eye out for the grand opening occurring later in 2026!

What do we want for the future? Do we want more academic classes? Do we want more ways to explore the arts, both performing and practical? Do we hope for a place where the kids can safely study? Yes, yes, and yes! All of these hopes and so much more are coming our way.

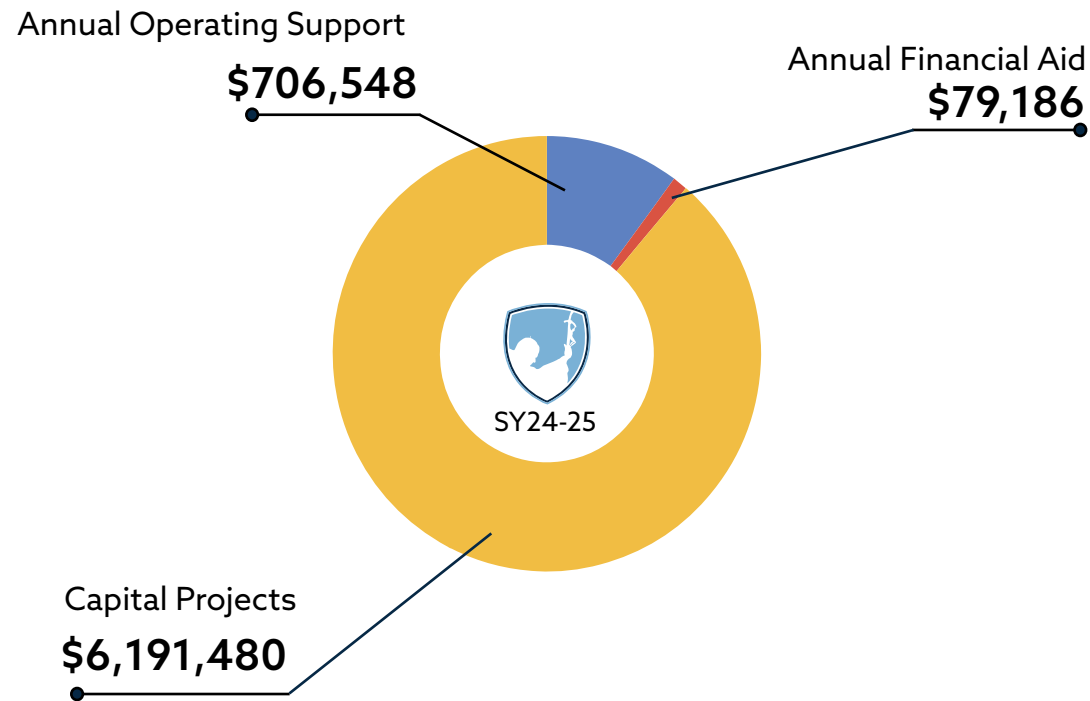
By The Numbers

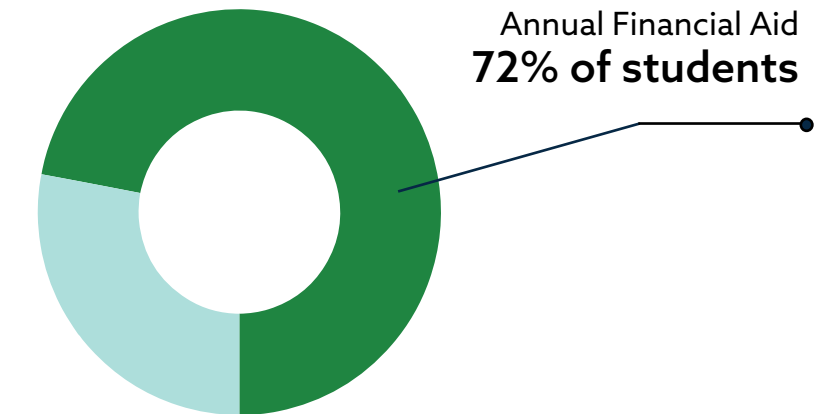
