JPIIHS Ladies' Uniform Policy

Ladies are to wear the below uniform options without variance. Outerwear and skirts/skortis must be purchased directly from Land's End; other uniform pieces are highly recommended to be purchased from Land's End for uniformity of color and style.

Please note: any clothing or accessories which meet the technical requirements but are not worn in a spirit of professionalism and dignity are subject to correction.

Daily Wear:

- Skirts/Skortis
 - Blue plaid
 - MUST be purchased from Land's End
 - Skirts/skortis must fall within 3 inches above the knee- if a style of skirt or skort does not fit this requirement, the garment should be returned for a different or altered to fit properly; skirts that do not meet the length requirement will not be allowed to be worn with no exceptions
 - Cannot be rolled, hiked up, or otherwise shortened

- Pants & Shorts
 - Khaki or navy
 - Must be the right size (not too big or too small) and should not be either too loose or too tight
 - Highly recommended be purchased from the uniform store to ensure uniformity of fabric and color
 - Khaki or navy-colored denim is not allowed; pants must be straight legged and simple
 - Shorts must be no shorter than mid-thigh
- Oxford Shirt
 - White or blue
 - Basic Oxford shirt: long or short sleeves allowed (polos and blouses not



permitted)

- Shirts must be tucked in at all times, even if worn under outerwear
- Embroidered logo is optional

* Please note: if an undershirt is worn underneath the oxford, it cannot have words, logo, color, or design visible through the oxford and must be tucked in properly

- Modesty Shorts
 - Navy or Black
 - Modesty shorts are to be always worn under skirts (not required for skirt)
- Ties (optional)
 - Navy cross tie
 - Blue plaid traditional tie
- Knee Socks (optional)
 - White or navy
 - Knee highs- must not extend above the knee
- Tights (optional)
 - Black or Navy
 - Tights must be solid (sheer or opaque) and cannot be patterned whatsoever
 - Tights with runs or rips should not be worn
- Shoes
 - Shoes must be traditional dress shoes intended for formal, business, or school-uniform wear. Shoes must be solid-colored, neutral in color, closed-toe, closed-heel, and in good repair. Colors may include: black, gray, brown, tan, navy. Athletic shoes, sneakers, slippers, casual boots, sandals, and other non-dress footwear are not permitted.
 - Examples of acceptable girls' shoes: Flats, loafers, Mary Janes, Oxfords, low-heeled pumps, dress boots.

Outerwear:

- Blazers, Sweaters, Vests (optional)
 - Navy with school logo
 - MUST be purchased from Land's End
 - Other outerwear may be worn into & out of the building, but must be removed once the student enters the school hallways

Hair, Make-Up and Accessories

- Makeup should look natural, tasteful, and not distracting.
- Nail polish is allowed but should be muted, tasteful, and professional.
- Hair accessories should be tasteful and professional.
- Hats or head coverings are not to be worn during school hours (chapel veils are allowed for Mass and prayer)
- Earrings should be in the ear only and must be tasteful. No gauges. No facial or visible bodily piercings.
- All jewelry should be tasteful, professional, and not excessive in size or number.
- Hair color should be natural hues. No streaks of unnatural colors (blues, pinks, greens, etc.) on any part of hair.

Daily Wear

- Pants & Shorts
 - Khaki or navy
 - Pants must be the right size (not too big or too small)
 - Pants are highly recommended be purchased from the uniform store to ensure uniformity of fabric and color
 - Khaki or navy-colored jeans are not allowed
 - Shorts must be no shorter than mid-thigh
- Oxford Shirt
 - White or blue
 - Basic Oxford shirt: long or short sleeves allowed (polos not permitted)
 - Shirts must be tucked in at all times, even if worn under outerwear
 - Embroidered logo is optional
 - * Please note: if an undershirt is worn underneath the oxford, it cannot have words, logo, color, or design visible through the oxford and must be tucked in properly
- Socks
 - Black or navy or white
 - No obvious logos
- Tie
 - Blue plaid
 - Strong preference for tie on Land's End site
 - Ties can also be school colors (navy, light blue, white, gray) or black; no other colors or distracting patterns, please
- Belt
 - Belt must be worn with pants
 - Must be of a neutral color



- Shoes
 - Shoes must be traditional dress shoes intended for formal, business, or school-uniform wear. Shoes must be solid-colored, neutral in color, closed-toe, closed-heel, and in good repair. Colors may include: black, gray, brown, tan, navy. Athletic shoes, sneakers, slippers, casual boots, sandals, and other non-dress footwear are not permitted.
 - Examples of acceptable boys' shoes: Oxfords, derbies, loafers, monk straps, dress boots.

Outerwear:

- Blazers, Sweaters, Vests (optional)
 - Navy with school logo
 - MUST be purchased from Land's End
 - Other outerwear may be worn into & out of the building, but must be removed once the student enters the school hallways

Hair and Accessories

- Hair should be above the shirt collar
- All young men should be clean-shaven
- Simple chains and medals should be tucked under the shirt
- No earrings or gauges; No visible piercings or tattoos
- No visible undergarments
- Uniform is to be worn at all times while on campus and must not be altered in any way- for example, Oxford shirts must remain on, buttoned, and tucked at all times while on school premises. Faculty and staff members may, at their discretion, allow for exceptions to this rule during lunch times and physical activities
- Hats are not to be worn while on school property

JPIIHS Out-of-Uniform Dress Code

The JPIIHS community appreciates a full life, enjoying sporting events, dances, and fine art performances both on campus and off campus. The expectation is that all students present themselves in a way that reflects their great dignity, and to dress in a modest and neat way at all JPIIHS events, including those that occur outside of our normal school day.

1. SEMI-FORMAL AND FORMAL SCHOOL DAYS/EVENTS

LADIES

- Semi-formal dress required (dress, dress pants and tops, skirts)
- Dresses and slit length must be within 3 inches above the knee or longer
- If leggings are worn, they must be worn underneath a skirt or dress, not as pants on their own
- Dresses can be any strap style (including strapless), but must be modest (no lower back exposure - no lower than mid-back, no exposed cleavage or midriffs, no transparent/translucent fabrics).
- Dress shoes (no Keds, Vans, Sperry, Toms or Converse-type shoes)
- Shawl or sweater must be worn with sleeveless or strapless garments during Mass and classes
- No visible undergarments
- FOR FORMAL EVENTS: dresses must be floor-length

GENTLEMEN

- Semi-formal dress required (khaki's or better slacks, dress shirt)
- No jeans or shorts
- No sleeveless shirts or t-shirts
- No athletic shoes or Sperry, Vans, Toms, Converse-type shoes
- Pants and shirts should be properly fitting (appropriate tightness/looseness)
- No visible undergarments
- FOR FORMAL EVENTS: suit coats are required, ties are recommended

NOTE: Dress code for all events will be reiterated prior to the events, but will always reflect these parameters

2. DRESS DOWN OR COSTUMED DAYS

- Dress and skirt length should match uniform skirt length, which is within 3 inches above the knee
- When shorts are permitted, shorts must not be shorter than mid-thigh
- No excessively tight-fitting pants or tops
- No midriff exposed
- No sleeveless attire



- No ratty, stained clothing
- No undergarments showing at any time
- If jeans are allowed, they must not have holes or be excessively tight or loose
- No sweatpants, joggers, or athletic pants may be worn at any time
- If leggings are worn, they must be worn underneath a skirt or dress, not as pants on their own
- Any clothing or accessories that are deemed questionable may be prohibited
- Exceptions to this policy may be made by faculty or staff for retreats or field days; exceptions will be publicly announced and disseminated
- Full-face masks are not permitted
- Some costumes worn for spirit days may not be worn during Mass

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
